



Worksheet C8: Time Capsule

Do this with Lesson 10.

The year is 2197. "Our" historic building (Lesson 8) is no longer meeting the needs of the people who own it. You want to send a message to them telling them why you want them to conserve this building and its contents, and what it means to you.

1. Say why you think they should conserve it.
2. Suggest some alternative uses for the building to keep it alive.
3. Use photocopies of the drawings and photographs which the class collected on the field trip, including the elevation and floor plan. Make a drawing of the building to show how it might be adapted to a new function in the future.
4. How would you use the interior spaces?
5. Should the appearance of the building be altered in any way? If so, how?
6. If new elements or features are to be added, what would be the most appropriate materials/shapes to use?
7. What should be done with the contents of the building, e.g. furniture, sculptures, paintings etc.
